BRIEF BIOGRAPHICAL PROFILE

Grace Maud Aguilar, daughter of Henry Elias and Laura Annie (Williams) Aguilar, was an influential Australian New Thought leader, writer and self-publisher. In the words of The Brisbane Courier, 15

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July 1926), [her] work has claimed the attention of the world'. She was said by her husband to have been the first to introduce Unity [that is, Unity School of Christianity, now known simply as Unity] teachings and literature to Australia. An early feminist, she advocated female empowerment in her writings and speeches.

The surname Aguilar is of Galician origin; it is usually Spanish, but can also be Portuguese and Ashkenasic.

Grace Maud Aguilar, whose parents had met and married in England before emigrating to Australia, was born in Maryborough, Queensland, Australia on May 16, 1881. (Maryborough is also the birthplace of Pamela Lyndon Travers OBE (1899-1996), the creator of Mary Poppins.) Aguilar's father, Henry Elias Aguilar (1857-1940), a commercial traveller, was also an exponent of New Thought (or 'Higher Thought', as it was also called at that time) and a writer (author of the booklet Millions and Millions of Money for Public Works, Free from Interest (1903)).

Her mother's uncle was Sir George Williams (1821-1905), the English merchant and founder of the Young Men's Christian Association (YMCA), and she was the grandniece of the English novelist, poet and writer on Jewish history and religion, Grace Aguilar (1816-1847), author of The Women of Israel, Records of Israel, Spirit of Judaism and other books.

Aguilar's father Henry was associated with Dr James Porter Mills MD (1847-1926) and his wife Anna W Mills, American metaphysicians, formerly of Chicago. Henry Aguilar had attended one of Dr Mills's public lectures in Brisbane and embraced New Thought. In the early 1890s Dr Mills, a minister's son who had degrees both from Chicago and Philadelphia medical colleges, came with his wife from the United States to Australia (he having given up his medical practice in Chicago), where they devoted themselves entirely to spiritual teaching and healing ('the Science of Self-Conscious Existence') from 1897 to 1898 and where, in Brisbane, they founded the Brisbane Christian Metaphysical Association.

Dr and Mills were the pioneers of New Thought in Australia, giving public lectures in the capital cities and elsewhere. Later (c1899), they visited India where, at the request of the famous Hindu monk Swami Vivekananda (1863-1902), Dr Mills gave a course of lectures in Vivekananda's monastery near Calcutta, which was eagerly received by Vivekananda's disciples. Further travels brought them finally to England (in mid-1899) where for nearly a year they taught and practised with much success in London. Later, they went back to Great Britain, living and working in London for some 13 years, where they established the Higher Health Centre and the 'New Order of Meditation', the latter based on what Mills called 'education of the intuition'. (The Irish political activist Charlotte Payne-Townsend (1857-1953), wife of Irish playwright George Bernard Shaw (1856-1950), and the British actress Lena Ashwell (1872-1957) were among Mills's more well-known 'disciples'.) The Mills briefly revisited Australia in 1900, lecturing in Sydney, Melbourne, Adelaide, Perth and Hobart, before departing for California. Dr Mills was the celebrated author of many early New Thought and metaphysical books including Illumination: Spiritual Healing (1914), Inspiration: The Great Within (1914), A New Order of Meditation (1915), From Existence to Life: The Science of Self-consciousness [formerly, Health, Abstract and Concrete] (1916) ('by far the best book yet published on advanced psychology and spiritual healing' [Judge Thomas Troward (1847-1916)]), and Mind's Silent Partner (1922). His particular teaching, in his words, had 'not only to do with spiritual psychology but also with pneumatology, the science of spiritual selfconsciousness'. (As a sidelight, Dr Mills had been a patient of Professor Sigmund Freud (1856-1939) in Vienna for three months.) Anna W Mills (who called herself 'Healer' and dabbled in Christian Science) wrote the first edition of her book Practical Metaphysics [full title, Practical Metaphysics for Healing and Self Culture] (1896) while staying at the Aguilar guesthouse in Brisbane, Queensland.

After the Aguilar family had moved to Brisbane, young Grace M Aguilar attended one of Dr Mills's Brisbane public addresses on metaphysics and is said to have later experienced a dramatic healing from rheumatic fever through prayer and 'absent treatment'. She then began a career as a New Thought teacher, healer and writer. At about the age of 18 she became honorary treasurer of the Brisbane Christian Metaphysical Association. A few years later she moved to Hobart, Tasmania where she studied metaphysics with prominent churchman Willoughby Connor (1855-1938), who was president of the Hobart Metaphysical Society for more than 30 years. While working for the soft goods emporium G P Fitzgerald & Co in Hobart from 1909 to 1910 she took up active work in the New Thought Movement, after Connor obtained a room for her. She opened her first Truth Centre in Hobart in 1910. Subsequently, she founded the Adelaide Truth Centre (later known as the New Thought Truth Centre) in Adelaide, South Australia in 1911, having paid her tram fare to Adelaide with a borrowed sixpence. She proceeded to rent a room and opened the Centre. It was while in Adelaide that she commenced publication and editorship of The Affirmer, an Australian New Thought monthly journal

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which was in publication for several decades. The first edition of the journal appeared in April 1915.

Later, she relocated her Truth Centre to Brisbane, Queensland (c1917-1919) and then to Sydney, New South Wales where, starting with premises in Gosvenor Street, she opened New Thought Centre, NSW (later New Thought Centre[s] of Australia, then New Thought Centres, Australia, still later New Thought Centre, Australia, and also New Thought Centres, (E) Australia), serving as leader longer than any other in the New Thought Movement in Australia. She was a long-serving District President of the International New Thought Alliance (INTA).

While living and working in Brisbane, Queensland, Aguilar lived Gregory Terrace, and later Herbert Street, Brisbane North. Subsequently, she lived at various times in Sandgate Road, Clayfield, and also Albion Road, Windsor, both being inner northern suburbs in the City of Brisbane. Later, when she moved to Sydney, New South Wales, she lived throughout much of the 1930s in Seaforth Crescent, Seaforth ('New Thought Home') and later in nearby Fairlight. In 1937 and again in 1949 she lived in the family home at 'Major House', 35 Lower Fort Street, Millers Point, a c1834 Regency style terrace of rich architectural heritage. In 1943 she was residing at Jersey Road, Artarmon.

On September 28, 1949, some 18 years after their first meeting at the Manly School of Arts, Grace M Aguilar married dental technician Hector George Paul (1902-2002), son of William Sommerville and Alice (Webber) Paul, at the Manly Congregational Church, in Manly, New South Wales. For many years, Paul had assisted, and would continue to assist, Aguilar in her work. In time, he also became a prominent Australian New Thought leader. (Paul was born in Newton, New South Wales on August 29, 1902. From 1941 to 1946 he served in the Australian Army [59 Dental Unit], his rank upon discharge being staff sergeant. For many years he worked as a dental technician in the dental practice of Harry Jockel in Manly, New South Wales.)

An author, Aguilar wrote *New Thoughts: or Light in Our Darkness* (Grace M Aguilar, 1917), the play *Woman's Power* [two versions: children's play in two Acts/adult play in three Acts] (Brisbane, Qld: Grace M Aguilar/The Carter Watson Company [printer], 1917), which had its first production at the INTA Congress in St Louis, Missouri on August 4, 1917 ('New Thought Day'), the children's story *Who is Our Fairy Godmother?* (Sydney NSW: New Thought Centre, NSW: 1932), the historic novel *The Great Untouched Future* (Sydney NSW: New Thought Centre of Australia, 1938), and numerous poems, tracts, pamphlets, booklets and other miscellaneous writings. She also compiled the booklet *Thoughts by Many Authors* (Sydney NSW: Yates & Mann [printer], nd [193-?]) and published and edited *The Affirmer*. New Thought Centre Australia also published *Character in Verse* (1937), by Glory McDonald, being a collection of the author's poems.

With fellow Australian New Thought leader and practitioner Sr Veni Cooper-Mathieson (1867-1943) she cofounded the Australian New Thought Alliance (conferences 1916, 1928), with Australia's first 'New Thought Day' being held on October 7, 1916. In February 1916 Dr Julia Seton (1862-1950), founder of the Church and School of the New Civilization), came to Sydney to preside at the first Australian New Thought Conference. Dr Seton also lectured in Sydney from January 20 to March 30, 1916.

Over several decades, Grace M Aguilar led New Thought Centres in Brisbane, Queensland; Adelaide, South Australia; Sydney, New South Wales (Sydney City [various locations throughout the years, including the IOOF Temple in Elizabeth Street, The Dymocks Building in George Street, 114 Hunter Street, and the Teachers Federation Building ('Federation House') in Phillip Street] and Sydney suburbs, including, at various times and periods, Manly [in the Manly School of Arts (Manly Literary Institute), in Wentworth Street], Chatswood [Price's (Washington H Soul Pattinson) Building, cnr Victoria Road and Orchard Avenue], Lane Cove, Burwood, Parramatta, Hornsby, Eastwood and Dee Why); Newcastle (96 Hunter Street), New South Wales; Cowra, New South Wales (at the prisoner of war and internment camp, during World War II); and the Blue Mountains, New South Wales (Warrimoo [at home] and later Springwood). She also lectured and taught in Perth, Western Australia and Hobart, Tasmania.

During her time as a New Thought leader in Australia many famous overseas exponents of New Thought lectured and spoke at her Centres, including Professor James Adams ('Modern Mental Magic'), Professor W G Hooper (of the Royal Astronomical Society of London, and Field Secretary of the British Section of INTA), the abovementioned Dr Julia Seton [Seton-Sears] (1862-1950), and the Divine Science ministers and authors Dr Harry Gaze (1878-1959) and Dr Joseph Murphy (1898-1981). In his book *Travelling with God* (San Gabriel CA: Willing Publishing Company, 1956), Dr Murphy wrote (on p80): 'Mrs [sic] Grace Aguilar and her husband conduct the New Thought Movement in Sydney. They are most gracious and kind and have labored long in the vineyard.' Aguilar and her husband

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were also cited in *Spirits in Rebellion: The Rise and Development of New Thought* (Dallas TX: Southern Methodist University Press, 1963), the seminal history of the New Thought Movement, written by Charles S Braden who wrote in that book (on p489) that Aguilar was 'engaged in preparing a detailed history of New Thought in [Australia] which may run to two volumes'. Sadly, due to a severe stroke suffered by her in 1961, which left her partially paralysed and unable to speak, the work never saw the light of day.

Grace M Aguilar was a great admirer of the writings and teachings of F L Rawson (1859-1923), author of *Life Understood* (1912) and editor and publisher of the weekly publication *Active Service*. Rawson was a very influential New Thought leader in England in the early 20th century as well as being a pioneer in the field of the practical use of electricity and an engineer of the first company in the field of electric lighting.

In 1951 Aguilar and her husband built a house ('Intaa') in Spurwood Road, Warrimoo, in the Lower Blue Mountains of New South Wales, Australia. Until her death in 1964 she remained the president of New Thought Centre, Australia, having also served the body as both its president and treasurer at various times.

Grace M Aguilar Paul died at Governor Phillip Nursing Home in Penrith, New South Wales on May 22, 1964 of pneumonia and the effects of the stroke suffered three years earlier. She was 83 years of age. She had been the second patient to be admitted to that nursing home, on August 1, 1962. Prior to that (from 1961 to 1962) she had been a patient in Nepean District Hospital in Penrith. She was buried in Penrith General Cemetery on May 25, 1964 after services at the funeral home of John Price and Son, in Penrith, and at the gravesite. A memorial service was held in her honour at the New Thought Centre, YWCA Building, 189 Liverpool Street, Sydney on June 4 and again on June 18, 1964.

Her widower, H George Paul, continued her work as leader of the New Thought Centre, (E) Australia for many more years, with centres in the City of Sydney and at Springwood in the Lower Blue Mountains. He also operated a New Thought mail order distribution centre from his Warrimoo home where he continued to live until his early to mid-90s when circumstances made it necessary for him to move to the Lynvale Nursing Home in Lane Cove, a suburb on the Lower North Shore of Sydney. In conversation with others, he would always refer lovingly to his late wife as 'my dear wife Grace, who died in 1964'. He died at Lane Cove, New South Wales on July 18, 2002 at the age of 99, just one month before his 100th birthday. His funeral was held at The Garrison Church in Millers Point, Sydney, followed by a cremation at the Northern Suburbs Crematorium, in North Ryde.
