TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME I JOSHUA JONATHAN SMITH Lord Mayor of the City of London IN PURSUANCE OF AN ACT OF PARLIAMENT made and passed on the fifth year of the Reign of His Late Majesty King George the Second Intituled an act for the more easy Recovery of Debts in his ---- Majestys Plantations & Colonies in America Do hereby certify that on the day of the Date hereof Personally came and appeared before me Edward Bridges the Deponent named in the Affidavit hereunto annexed being a person well known and worthy of good Credit and by Solemn Oath which the 41/223 said Deponent then took before me upon the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God did Solemnly and Sincerely declare testify and Depose to be true the Several matters and things mentioned and contained in the said annexed affidavit.

KNOW YE that these presents witness that he the said Moses Baruh Lousada
for and in consideration of the sum of Ten shillings of good and Lawful
money of Great Britian by or on the behalf of the said Brown Girl Slave
named Mary Jane to him in hand at or before the ensceling and Delivery of
these Presents well and truly paid (the Receipt whereof is hereby ack-
nowledged he the said Moses Baruh Lousada hath manumitted Enfrenchised
Released and confirmed and for ever set free and by these presents doth
manumise Enfrenchise Release and for ever set free the said Brown Girl
Slave named Mary Jane with her future Issue and Increase Born since the
said Sixth day of November Last & hereinafter to be born of and from all
and all manner of Bondage future Servitude and Slavery whatsoever as well
in the said Island of Barbados as in say other Island part or place what-
soever where Providence may Order her or their Lot and Lots to be at all
times and time for ever hereafter and he the said Moses Baruh Lousada for
the Consideration aforesaid the Freedom of the Brown girl Slave named
Mary Jane and her future Issue Offspring and Increase Born from and since
the said sixth day of November Last and hereafter to be born against him
the said Moses Baruh Lousada his heirs Executors and administrators and

all and every other person and persons whomsoever Lawfully claiming or to claim by from under or in trust for him them or any of them shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof the said Moses Baruh Lousada in the presence of James Sutherland of the City of London Notary Public by Royal authority duly admitted and Sworn & the Witnesses hereunto subscribing hath hereunto set his hand/seal at London this Twenty fifth day of January in the fifty first year of the Reign of Our Sovereign Lord George the third By the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain & Ireland King Defender of the Faith etc. and in the year of Our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and Eleven.
