TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, ISAAC BARUH LOUSADA Esquire of London Merchant sendeth greeting KNOW YE that the said Isaac Baruh Lousada hath made constituted and appointed And by these presents doth make constitute appoint and fully authorise and empower JOSEPH BARROW Esquire of the Island of Barbados in the West Indies Merchant his partner in Trade to be his true and lawful Attorney and Procurator for him the said Isaac Baruh Lousada and in his name and on his behalf and to and for his use and benefit to ask demand sue for recover and receive All such sum and sums of money and securities for money, deeds, evidences, papers, vouchers, documents and writings, debts, goods, wares, merchandizes, chattles, property and effects whatsoever as now is or are And that shall or may hereafter be or become due owing payable belonging or in any wise appertaining to him the said Isaac Baruh Lousada in part or in whole either in partnership with the said Joseph Barrow under their firm of Barrow, Lousada and Company or on his own Sole or Seperate Account and in his own right or as Heir, Executor, Administrator, --- Legatee, Trustee or Assignee of any other person or persons whomsoever from or by or in the Hands Custody, or power of any person or persons in the said Island of Barbados or elsewhere in the West Indies or in the Colonies of Demerary, Berbice, Surinam or Essequibo and their respective Dependencies or in any other part or place whatsoever in the West Indies or America (the Island of Jamaica only excepted) by Bill,

T71/857: claim by Simon Barrow and Emanuel Lousada, St Ann, owners. Claim was originally recorded as 'Barrow and Louzados'.

T71/1606: letter dated 10/10/1835 from Barrow and Louzados, Sidmouth [Devon]: amount on this claim, the estimated value being £6510.

Joseph Sturge and Thomas Harvey, *The West Indies in 1837* (London, Hamilton, Adams, & Co., 1838) p. xliii: Banks and Richmond [See St Ann claim no. 435]: - Both these estates are under one attorney, the latter is the property of Ralph Bernal M.P. Out of crop, apprentices work from six to six, with intermissions of two hours and a half for breakfast and dinner. They have no half Fridays, no payment for extra labour, no salt fish, no field cooks. Invalids get no food, nor old people any support from the estate. Pregnant women are allowed no more time than on New Ground [a few days before confinement and 3 or 4 weeks afterwards]. They say it is useless to complain to the Magistrate; 'his hands shake so' that the overser always has to write the sentences for him.'

- 1841 census Simon Barrow Lansdowne Grove Bath aged 50 Independent with Jacob 30 Independent etc. 1851 census at Ryde age 64 magistrate, born London; 1861 census SB aged 74 fundholder living with Rev John Simeon Barrow. Simon Barrow late of Isle of Wight who died 30/12/1862 at Ryde, proved by Rev. John Simeon Barrow clerk son the sole executor. Effects under £3000; resworn August 1863 under £2000.
