This is the second list of 5404 (1644) of newly admitted members of the Portuguese Jewish Community of Amsterdam. The habit of recording new members once a year was carried on for a long time indeed, until at least 1874. I hope to publish them all here, but it will take some time. In case you wonder, the amounts are in Dutch guilders and it is the amount of the finta (tax) that this member had to pay each year.
