 as a further Codicil to my last will and Testament  
 bearing date the twenty fourth day of March in  
 the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety

five to which I have already made two codicils one bearing date the first day of April and the other the fifteenth day of December in the same year I do make subject all lands and slaves acquired by or in any wise become my property since the date of my said will to such power of sale and for such purposes as by my said will and former codicils are given and appointed of and concerning my plantations and other residuary real estate and slaves therein mentioned and I further will that all my real estate and slaves (that is my residuary estate) shall be sold for the best prices that may be gotten for the same save only my plantations called Carlisle and Kingats and the slaves thereon as which are still to remain subject to the limitation of being sold only at and upon such appraisement as in my said will prescribed and subject to such powers as aforesaid it is my will that all my lands and slaves acquired and taken as aforesaid shall go and pass under such residuary disposition and limitations as in my said will contained and shall also until sold be subject to such other powers of management and application of profits as in my said will contained as a mark of my consideration of good services rendered me by Isaac Joel and Esymon Phillips give unto each of them a legacy of fifty pounds currency to be paid as soon as conveniently may be after my decease as a small token of gratitude to Mr D Aguilar Esquire of Esquimaux Esquire for his kind attentions to my son Samuel in England I give to Mr one hundred Guineas to purchase a ring and as a little token to Mr Juditha Damsel Dowada Esquire of Esquimaux Dowada of London for attentions to my son Jacob who in England I give Mr one hundred Guineas to purchase a ring in all other things I hereby confirm my said will - Have so far as the same may have been altered or affected by my said former codicils and the said former codicils the witness whereof I have to the first page thereof out my hand and to this page my hand and seal this twentieth day of May in the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety six - E. B. Dowada (SE) signed sealed published and declared by Samuel Esquimaux Dowada the Testator as and for a codicil to his last will and Testament in the presence of us who in his presence at his request and in the presence of each other gave our subscribed names as witnesses - Jo.
