following that is to say Inprimis I will that all my
just Debts and the expenses of my funeral be fully
paid and satisfied with all convenient speed Item I
give and bequeath unto my Wife Esther Baruch
Lousada Twenty pounds of Current Money of this
Island to be divided at her discretion among the
poor of the Jewish Nation Item I give and bequeath
unto the Wardens and Treasurer for the time being
of the Portuguese Jews Synagogue in the Town of
Bristol One hundred pounds of like Money for
and towards the use and support of the said
Synagogue Item I give and bequeath to my Son
in Law Daniel Lousada twenty pounds of like Money
and to my Grand Daughter Abigail Lousada daughter
of the said Daniel Lousada upon her attaining the
age of twenty one years or being married which
shall first happen One thousand pounds of like Money
and I expressly declare that the said Legacy to my
said Grand Daughter is not to bear Interest Item I
give and bequeath unto my Sons Jacob Daniel Aaron
and Isaac Baruch Lousada one Annuity or yearly
Sum of One hundred and forty pounds of Current
Money aforesaid each to commence at my decease
and to continue until such time as they respectively
attain the age of twenty one years the said Annuitants
to be paid in two even and equal half yearly
payments and into the hands of my said wife so
long as she shall continue my Widow and to be
applied in maintaining clothing and educating my
said Sons respectively whereas my Cousin Isaac Lopez
Torres as by the will given to my Son Segarias
that is to say to Daniel Baruch Lousada five
hundred pounds to Jacob Baruch Lousada two
hundred pounds to Isaac Baruch Lousada two
hundred pounds and to Aaron Baruch Lousada One
thousand pounds upon their respectively attaining
the age of Eighteen years or being married which
shall first happen Now I do hereby give unto my
son Daniel Baruch Lousada the Sum of five hundred
pounds upon his attaining the age of twenty one
years unto my Son Jacob Baruch Lousada the Sum
of Eight hundred pounds upon his attaining that age
and unto my Son Isaac Baruch Lousada the like
Sum of Eight hundred pounds upon attaining that
age and I expressly declare that the said Legacies
are not to bear Interest until the same shall respectively
become due and shall lapse in case the Legacies
shall respectively die under age whereas the Sum
of six thousand pounds of Sterling Money of Great

Britain has been by good and sufficient ways and means in the said island as a provision for my said wife in case she should survive me in her and bar of power and have now I do hereby give and bequeath unto my said wife the further sum of two thousand pounds of current money of Jamaica together with all the plate which belonged to me before the death of my mother and all my jewels and such as came to me upon the death of my mother and upon the death of my cousin brother and all household furniture which may be in my house in the town of Kingston and my chariot and four of my horses to be taken by her self and it is my will that my said wife shall have the use and occupation of her house in Duke Street in the town of Kingston in which I reside with the lands belonging thereto so long as she shall remain my widow and in this island but upon condition that she shall keep the premises in repair at her own expense and if my said wife shall not reside there then it is my will that the said house and lands shall be sold by my Executors hereinafter named or some of them as shall act as such in this island for the time being the monies to arise from the sale to be put out to interest and the interest to be paid to my said wife and so long as she shall remain a widow but in case she shall happen to marry the said monies are to be applied in payment of my debts and in case of the marriage of my said wife in this island or if she shall neglect or omit to keep the premises in repair it is also my will that the said house and lands shall be sold by my Executors or some of them as aforesaid the monies to arise thereby to be applied in payment of my debts then I give and bequeath unto my said wife the following slaves to wit to wit (a) Mumbatta and Joan Gresser) Mumbatta Charles Dolly and her Mumbatta child Betty, Esther and her children Abaster and James Panda Robby and the children white Robby Elias and Maltawos Jimmy Wilson Frederick Tom Gratty July Robby Edwardina Dido Jissy and her child Cuba and a Samboc girl called Skilly to add the said slaves unto and to the use of my said wife her heirs and assigns for ever but it is my intention and will that the provision hereby and before made for my said

 Great Britain Merchants my Cousin Isaac
 Aguilar and my friend David Samuda both of
 London attorneys and my friend George Goodin
 Barrett of the parish of St. Andrew and Alexander
 Rindo Josefa Aguilar Daniel Groon and Jasper
 Farmer all of Kingston in this Island Executors
 of this my will and Guardians of the persons
 and Estates of my said sons during their
 respective Minorities and I do also appoint my
 said wife during her widowhood but no longer
 an Executrix of my will and Guardians of the
 persons and Estates of my said sons and it is
 my will that until my Real Estates and Goods
 shall be sold under the power aforesaid the
 same shall be managed by my Executors and
 Executrix or some of them as shall at us
 seeme in this Island for the time being and the
 produce be applied in payment of my Debts

and Legacies until the same shall be fully paid
off and it is also my Will that in case my Real
Estate and Slaves shall not be sold under the
power aforesaid the whole thereof and so
much and such part or parts as shall
remain unsold shall be managed by my
Executors or some of them as shall sit abode
in this Island for the time being until the
youngest of my said Sons that may live shall
attain his age of twenty one year but in case
my Debts shall be paid off before that period
than my Sons who shall respectively attain the
age of twenty one year shall hereafter be
paid their respective Shares of the Divids and
profits by my Executors or some of them as
aforesaid from time to time and I do hereby
empower my said Executors or some of them
as shall sit as such in this Island for the
time being to purchase and put on my said
plantation from time to time so long as they
or any of them shall continue in the
possession and Management of my said
plantations or any of them such Negroes as
may appear to be wanted for the same not
exceeding in any one year ten for the
plantations in Barbados nor the same number
for those in Saint Davids the same to be paid
for by and out of my Estate and the Divids
and profits thereof and to be subject to the
same powers and go in the same manner with
my Residuary Estate and I hereby revoke all
others Wills by me made declaring this to be my
last Will and Testament In Witness whereof
I have set my hand to the two first pages
hereof and to this last page my hand and
seal this twentieth day of March in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven

thereof to each of my said Sons an annuity or
yearly sum of two hundred pounds current
money aforesaid to commence and continue at
and for such time as in my said will is
mentioned respecting the said annuities of one
hundred and forty pounds and my will is that
the said annuities of two hundred pounds are
to be paid into the hands of my said wife so
long as she shall continue a widow by two
even and equal half yearly payments until my
said Sons respectively shall attain the age of
eighteen years to be applied in maintaining
Educating and Cloathing my said Sons
respectively and from and immediately after
any of their attaining that age the annuity or
annuities of two hundred pounds shall be paid as follows one half into the
