I should owe at the time of my decease & order to be discharged by my Executrix hereafter named and to what property I shall be possessed of Arriues standing in the three per Cent Consols standing in the name & name of my late Wife Ann Basalle or in my own name or whatever Goods or Chattels of whatever nature or kind I give and bequeath to the Sister of my late Wife Ann Basalle that is to say Elizabeth Grand Spinster of the parish and County aforesaid for her sole use and I also give and bequeath as a small gratuity to Mary Edwards Spinster the sum of five pounds for her attendance upon me provided she shall be in the service of my aforesaid Sister at the time of my decease and I do constitute and appoint the aforesaid Elizabeth Grand to be sole Executrix & Witnesses whereof I have set my hand and seal herunto this thirteenth day of May in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty four Isaac Basalle & Ed signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us Mary Ann Child & Tho Forest

**This Will** was proved at London the thirteenth day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight before the Worshipful John Nicholl Doctor of Laws surrogate of the Right Worshipful Peter Calvert Doctor of Laws Master & Keeper or Commissary of the prerogative Court of Canterbury lawfully constituted by the Oath of Elizabeth Grand Spinster the sole Executrix named in the said Will to whom Administration was granted of all and singular the Goods Chattels and Credits of the deceased having been first sworn duly to administer.

 my last Will and Testament London the 12<sup>th</sup> Decr 1786

 Jeremiah Barah H. Matthews.

Husband the said Henry Lys his heirs Executors &  
Administrators and assigns and I do hereby nominate &  
constitute and appoint my said Husband Henry Lys sole  
Executor of this my last Will and Testament hereby  
and revoking all Wills by me at any time heretofore made  
and declaring this only to be my last Will and Testament  
In Witness whereof I have to this my said last Will  
and Testament contained in this and the other side  
hereof set my hand to the former side hereof and my  
hand and seal hereto this twentieth eighth Day of
